## Part III – Requirements & Expectations

- 1. "Sailors Without Borders "" is a young and small non-profit foundation, registered under "Endangered Planet Foundation" 501(c)3 #205931830 in the USA. As such we currently have no funds to pay for volunteers travel, food and expenses. All volunteers have to pay for their own travel.
- 2. We like Crew/Interns to work with us getting the trip organized and the boat prepared for 2-4 days prior to loading starting around March 25, 2011. Are you available for that time?
- 3. Food and other onboard expenses including fuel, water, additional safety equipment, security, sat phone & air time, vessel tracking, etc. will be a tax deductable contribution of \$200 per week. Made at or prior to your arrival.
- 4. Health, liability, accident insurance, and all shots and vaccines will be up to the individual.
- 5. If for any reason there is a problem, with insubordination, crew compatibility, theft, drugs, alcohol, and danger to yourself, ship or other crewmembers. You will be asked to depart the vessel upon arrival at the next Port of Call at your own expense.
- 6. If for any reason there is an accident, either whilst on board or ashore and you need to depart early, we will aid you in any way possible, but the ultimate financial responsibility is up to the individual.
- 7. The Captain of "Tranquility" holds a 3000 ton International License and has been in the industry for over 25 years. That being said the <u>Captain has the final ruling with regards to the Safe</u>
  <u>Operation of the Vessel & Her Crew.</u>
- 8. By signing below you agree that you have read and understand the above requirements & expectations and that you are embarking on this voyage as a voluntary humanitarian effort. You also agree that this signature acts as a release indemnifying "Sailors Without Borders ", "Endangered Planet Foundation", yacht "Tranquility", owners "Captain Cameron & Leighia Murray", "Trans Marine LLC", and/or any other person directly related to the afore mentioned.
